

## GENERAL SUPPLIES

- ☐ Crate or Suitcase on wheels large enough to hold backpacks, lunch and supplies. Make sure student's name is on crate.
- ☐ K- reusable shopping bag, 1 backpack
- ☐ 1<sup>st</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> grades-2 Backpacks – one for morning, one for afternoon. Label backpacks with student's name.
  - o One smaller bag for bringing in work to turn in. Reusable shopping bags work great!
