

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- ☐ K-6th Grade-Crate or Suitcase on wheels large enough to hold backpacks, lunch and supplies. Make sure student's name is on crate.
- ☐ KinderPrep-one backpack. We suggest a rolling one.
- ☐ Kindergarten- reusable shopping bag and 1 backpack. Label backpack with student's name
- ☐ 1st- 6th grades-2 Backpacks – one for morning, one for afternoon. Label backpacks with student's name.
- ☐ 1st-5th grades-One smaller bag for bringing in work to turn in. Reusable shopping bags work great!
- ☐ Lunch Box with student's name
- ☐ Water Bottle – with closeable lid that doesn't "sweat." Please label.
- ☐ One small package of Post-It Tabs: These will be used to save pages in student workbooks. Parents, bring to parent orientation on August 7th.
