### **FEES**

- New Family Application Fee: \$50 application fee per-family non-refundable and non-transferable.
- New Student Testing Fee: \$65 per student (\$35 for only math, or language arts).
- <u>Tuition Deposit</u>: \$250 per family non-refundable. Due after acceptance when you sign your Financial Agreement. This deposit holds your spot and is applied to future tuition payment(s).

### HALF-DAY

KinderPrep - 6th grade students may choose a morning or afternoon 1/2 day option:

- 1. <u>Morning</u>: Bible, Math and Language Arts. The morning option runs from 9 a.m. 12 p.m. Students are welcome to bring a packed lunch and stay on campus until 12:20 p.m.
- 2. <u>Afternoon</u>: History, Science, Latin and Enrichment Eelectives. Enrichment Elective courses are selected before the start of each semester. The afternoon option runs from 12:20 p.m. 3:30 p.m. Students are welcome to bring a packed lunch and meet on campus in the cafeteria at 12 p.m.

## Guidance Counseling Package

- Periodic emails with general, grade-level guidance information: SAT/ACT testing, scholarships, college and financial aid deadlines, etc.
- 11th Grade: year-end meeting: 1-2 hour meeting
- 12th Grade: final transcript review and exit interview

## **OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS**

The responsibility of parents to raise their children to love the Lord and walk in His truth is the calling of every parent. We believe Christian education is vital in this pursuit. To that end, we want to help make CCA affordable for parents.

Our CCA Scholarship program awards scholarships based on the financial needs of our student body. Because the half-day Hybrid and Flex programs allow families to customize their CCA experience to meet their schedule and financial needs, Opportunity Scholarships are reserved for families with full-time students in our Hybrid Program.

Our scholarships are funded by donations and by a percentage of our operating budget. As such, available funds may vary from year-to-year.

## How to Apply:

- Complete enrollment for a full-time Hybrid student. If you apply for an Opportunity Scholarship and the amount received is not enough, you can end your enrollment at CCA and your Financial Agreement will be voided.
- 2. Determine that you meet the eligibility requirements:
  - Have students new or returning enrolled in K-12th grade at CCA. (Enrollment must be complete.)
  - Demonstrate a financial need and provide a copy of 2 years of tax returns.
  - The family is current with all money owed to CCA.
  - Returning families must provide a copy of Jupiter comments for all students in the family.
- 3. Visit <a href="https://www.discovercca.org/scholarships-tuition-assistance">https://www.discovercca.org/scholarships-tuition-assistance</a> . There is a button at the end of the page that takes you to our application form. The deadline to apply is the 5th of each month at midnight.

## What happens next?

Applications are reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. The names will be removed from applications to share with the Committee. The Committee will review all applications, vote and prepare its recommendations to the Board of Directors for approval. Families will be notified of awarded scholarships as soon as the Board makes its final decision. This will be handled by the school Principal or her designee.
